VACCINATION UPDATE

The vaccine is now more widely available and there is no shortage. Ohioans can visit gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov to look for open appointments or call 833-4-ASK-ODH to book an appointment over the phone.

More than 4.4 million Ohioans—or 38%-- have received their first vaccine shot.

Businesses: Businesses who want to partner with vaccine providers to vaccinate their employees at work should visit coronavirus.ohio.gov.

High Schools, Colleges and Universities: The state is working with high schools, colleges and universities to offer vaccination clinics for students who are 16 or older.

Johnson & Johnson Vaccine: Vaccine providers are permitted to resume Johnson & Johnson vaccinations in Ohio.
