

USAGE OF WHEELED DEVICES POLICY

Division: Student Affairs

Policy Statement

No person shall operate or electrically charge a wheeled personal device inside college property unless used to accommodate for a disability. This includes, but is not limited to: bicycles, skateboards, hoverboards, Segways, and similar devices.

Policy Details

- A. Any person observed operating or charging a wheeled personal device that does not directly accommodate a disability inside a campus property shall be reported to the Campus Safety Office at 419-559-2253.
- B. A Campus Safety Officer shall immediately investigate and, if a violation has occurred, shall:
 - a. Report the student to the Dean of Student Success
 - b. Report the employee to their direct supervisor

<i>Term</i>	Definition
<i>Wheeled Personal Device</i>	Any motorized or non-motorized device with wheels including, but not limited to; bicycles, roller skates, in-line skates, skateboards, scooters, electric bikes, electric scooters, hoverboards, Segway's, or other similar devices.
<i>Segway</i>	A two-wheeled, motorized, self-balancing, personal vehicle made by Segway Inc.
<i>Hoverboard</i>	A motorized personal vehicle with a platform and wheels, which is controlled by how the user distributes weight. These are oftentimes electric vehicles.
