Terra State Community College *Testing Dates & Process*

Why ATI TEAS

A requirement for admission to the Terra State Community College nursing program is that nursing applicants take the ATI TEAS test. Applicants must receive a score of PROFICIENT. Applicants may only take the ATI TEAS test twice to maintain admissions eligibility for the Terra State Community College nursing program.

TEAS Test Cost

The test cost is approximately \$120.00 and must be paid online with a credit card at registration. Terra State Community College does not schedule or take payments for the TEAS Test.

To Register for TEAS

Applicants will register for the ATI TEAS Test online at <https://www.atitesting.com/>.

- Select **TEAS**, and from the drop-down menu, choose **Register for TEAS**
- Click **Register Now**
 - When asked how you would like to take the proctored TEAS exam, choose **In-Person***
- Now you can search for a TEAS Test time
 - In Program Type, select **TEAS for Nursing Students**
 - In 'Search By,' choose **School Name**
 - In 'State,' choose **OH**
 - In School, choose **Terra State Community College**
 - Once you click search, you will be given a list of available dates and times for the TEAS Test.
 - Click **Select** for the date and time you wish to register. Follow the instructions given.

***All students applying to the Terra Nursing Program must take the TEAS Test In-Person at TSCC.**

TEAS Test Day

Testing is done on campus at Terra State Community College in the Academic Service Center, Building B, Room 105. You must bring one form of valid photo identification (Driver's License, State ID, Terra ID) and a copy of your registration forms from ATI.

The Results

A minimum of PROFICIENT is required for Admission eligibility to the Nursing Program. If you are unhappy with your results, you may retake the TEAS test. However, you may only take the TEAS Test twice to maintain admissions eligibility for the Terra State Community College nursing program.

What's Next

After you take the TEAS test, please submit your TEAS results to your Academic Enrollment Advisor. After testing, you will meet with your Academic Enrollment Advisor to review your TEAS results, GPA Calculation, and Points Rubric (minimum of 8 points). If you meet all requirements for admission, you will be given an application for the nursing program in that meeting.
